GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION:

4. The "NO" list for rehearsals is as follows: gum, candy, talking out of turn, cell phones, ipods, video games, no smart phones, hats, and please, **NO LITTERING!**
5. Chair placement will take place the morning Camp opens. The following proficiencies are suggested:
 - a) Major scales (concert A flat, E flat, B flat, F and an G(one octave minimum).
 - b) Chromatic scale beginning on concert B flat (one octave minimum).
 - c) 16 measures of a prepared solo or an excerpt from school music.
 - d) Sight-reading
6. On and off-street parking is available.
7. T-shirts will be given out Thursday July 26, the day before the concert.
8. Observers of daily program are welcome, but must sign in and out.

CAMP RAFFLES:
